1. I find it my duty that I send this message to both of my priests, partly in response to the recent survey which was recently distributed in the church.

Pope Benedict XVI once said that the globalisation of society is not only economic, but there is also a "globalization of responsibilities, a universality in which we are all responsible for everyone".
